

Step 8

Select the Exam you are taking

1. Obtain the password and log into the correct exam for your category certification.
2. Complete the exam. A 70% or better grade must be achieved.
3. Upon successful completion of the exam, make sure you save, email or print your certificate. Email or give the certificate (or reported to POST and added into your training record.
4. If the exam is not successfully completed, contact your Academy personnel or your agency's single-point-of-contact, as app


