Dear Sheriff's, Chief's, Constable's, and Law Enforcement Supervisors,

The Pershing County Sheriff's Office is preparing for the annual Burning Man event in the Black Rock Desert area of Pershing County. This year the event runs from August 21 through September 5, 2019.

We again need to supplement our manpower for the event and are requesting your assistance.

We are requesting Category I Officers that would be cross-deputized and assigned to Pershing County Sheriff's Office for the duration of the event. Officers will be paid \$30.00 per hour for their services; lodging and per diem will be provided. Although we provide law enforcement services for approximately thirteen (13) days, we can utilize officers for as few as two (2) days. However, officers that can work the entire event are most effective.

If you are able to provide officers, please contact us as soon as possible so we can schedule them according to their availability. If an officer has access to a motor home and can use it for lodging on site, we can provide for hook ups-electrical, water and waste removal-off playa.
