With two recent retirements, the Emmett Police Department is accepting applications for the position of full time “Police Officer”. This opening is for Lateral Police Officers and POST Patrol Certifiable applicants only. Applications will be considered for the current position and will be retained for 6 months on a hiring list for any future openings.

This opening will close on **August 25th, 2017 at 5:00 PM**. At the end of the closing date, selected applicants will be invited for oral interviews, physical fitness test and a written exam. Expected hire date is on or before **October 1st, 2017**. #### Requirements:

- \* At least 21 years of age
- \* Minimum of a High School diploma or GED
- \* Must be able to complete POST physical agility requirements
- \* Must have a clean background and pass extensive background check
- \* Pass employment based polygraph, drug testing and psychological exam
- \* Must possess a minimum of a POST Basic Certification or ability to challenge and obtain Idaho certification within six months of employment.

The City of Emmett is located about 30 miles North of the Boise, Meridian and Nampa area. Emmett is a growing community that serves just over 6,000 people. We have 4 schools within the city limits and several new businesses. Emmett is close to several recreation type activities including motocross, golf, ATV riding, hiking, fishing, hunting, boating, horse events, camping and many more.

We have 13 Sworn Officers, 4 Reserve Officers, 5 Citizen’s on Patrol Members and 2 Civilian Clerks. Future opportunities may include drug K9, School Resource Officer (SRO), Drug Enforcement Officer and Investigations. A wide variety of training opportunities are provided to all officers.
