Nevada VINE is a free and anonymous telephone or internet based service that provides victims of crime, victim advocates, and law enforcement agencies two important features: information and notification. The Nevada Statewide VINE service is provided by the Nevada Office of the Attorney General and your local law enforcement agency. Nevada VINE monitors the custody status of offenders, and provides it to victims 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

This is a great service to crime victims but only if they are informed.
