

Introduction to Sexual Assault Investigation for the Rural Executive Online

Rural law enforcement executives have the opportunity to influence those they supervise and their community's attitude toward sexual assault. They are responsible for creating and maintaining an environment that supports a victim centered response to sexual assault. This course will enhance the capability of rural law enforcement personnel to manage and investigate sexual assault cases in their community. Obstacles, resources and benefits to the department will also be explored. This online training will include scenarios to enhance the information given as well as videos and audio narration. Courses will be available 24 hours a day and 7 days a week for a specified period of time.


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
