

Introduction to Sexual Assault Investigation for the Rural Investigator Online

A Free Online Program from the Criminal Justice Institute

This online course is designed to enable rural officers to better understand the impact of sexual assault upon victims as well as apprehend the offender. The response to, and investigation of, sexual assault crimes requires a victim-centered approach as part of an effective investigation. The course includes recognizing victim trauma, understanding the medical forensic exam process, using effective victim interviewing techniques, and strategies for investigating and preparing sexual assault cases for prosecution. This online training will include scenarios to enhance the information given as well as videos and audio narration. 
