This year's training is specifically designed to apply to Field Training Officers and Field Trainers working in Patrol, Detention, and Communications, with 3 individual morning breakout sessions offered for each section with an additional session for all attendees on a common topic.

For Patrol: *Managing High-Risk Patrol Tactics*

Sergeant Mike Odle has been a Police Officer for the City of Los Angeles since May 1979 - Assigned to Metropolitan Division, Special Weapons And Tactics (SWAT) team in April of 1985. As a Team Leader, he's performed duties and participated in hundreds of SWAT-related incidents (1000+). These duties include: Responding to and resolving Barricaded Suspect incidents, preparing and serving of High-Risk Arrest and Search Warrants, providing security to V.I.P.'s visiting Los Angeles, responding to alleged terrorist activity, coordinating tactical operations with negotiation teams to defeat those threats, and providing training to both LAPD Officers and SWAT team personnel. Instructor and Firearms Chairperson for the National Tactical Officer's Association, International Association of Chiefs of Police, United States Department of Energy at their Central Training Academy, International Association of Law Enforcement Firearms Instructors, United States, Department of State, Bureau of Diplomatic Security, Anti-terrorist Assistance Program and Department of Homeland Security.

For Corrections: *Managing Change in Corrections*

Lieutenant Nita Schmidt has been with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department for 13 years and is currently assigned to the Central Booking Bureau of the Clark County Detention Center which is the largest jail in Nevada. Lt. Schmidt is also the Field Training Coordinator and Division Field Training Lieutenant and has been involved with field training for over eight years. In addition to supervisory experience, Lt. Schmidt has been assigned as a Policy and Procedures and Medical Liaison Officer. As a Nevada POST certified instructor, Lt. Schmidt has taught courses in Field Training, Leadership, Direct Supervision of Inmates, Suicide Prevention, Accreditation and is currently working on a Mental Health Project. She has a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology and is completing a Master's Degree in Criminal Justice both from the University of Nevada.

For Communication: *Advanced Communications Training Officer*

Jamie Hudson has 23 years of law enforcement experience as a Police Dispatcher, with the last 5 as a Dispatch Supervisor for the Elk Grove Police Department. He has worked at 3 dispatch centers, ranging from a solo dispatcher operation, to an operation with up to 13 dispatchers on duty at any given time. Jamie has served as a Dispatch Training Officer, Dispatch Training Instructor, and Lead Dispatcher as ancillary roles throughout his career. Jamie has designed and instructed several California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) certified courses. Jamie is a certified POST Master Instructor, completing all 4 levels of the Instructor Development Institute. He served on the POST Communications Training Officer Advisory Board; assisting with the revising of POST's CTO standards. He was selected to help develop a 40-hour Tactical Dispatch course for POST, for which he was selected as the Lead Instructor to present it.
