Supervision of Police Personnel prepares students for a successful transition from officer to supervisor and provides a solid foundation for managerial positions throughout law enforcement careers.

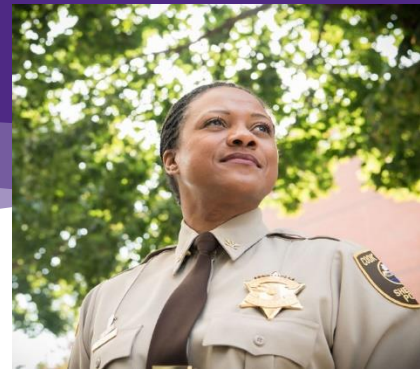
