Nevada POST is currently accepting applications for contract Instructor Facilitator to conduct Virtual Reality training throughout the State in Ethical Use of Force, De-Escalation and Critical Decision Making. Nevada POST received JAG Grant funding to purchase a Virtual Reality Training System from Apex Officer in Las Vegas. The position pays \$25.00 per hour (up to \$9,000).
