Nevada POST is currently accepting applications for contract Instructor Facili-
tator to conduct Virtual Reality training throughout the State in Ethical Use of
Force, De-Escalation and Critical Decision Making. Nevada POST received
JAG Grant funding to purchase a Virtual Reality Training System from Apex
Officer in Las Vegas. The position pays \$25.00 per hour (up to \$9,000). Travel

As a reminder, only those administering the test for official record certification purposes are required to be PPFT Administrator certified. Those who are conducting PPFT's for hiring/recruiting purposes, or in a capacity other than the officer's record certification PPFT, are not required to be PPFT Administrator certified.

POST is preparing an informational online PPFT course specifically for attendees that only conduct non-record PPFT's. Those who attend this course will receive a Certificate of Completion but will not receive a PPFT Administrator's certification number. Stay tuned for more information and course release updates.
