Professional Course Certification Update

Please be advised that effective immediately, all professional development courses certified by agencies will have an expiration date two years from certification. If your course is still active and being taught, you will be required to submit updated documentation at the 2-year mark in order to keep your course active. Dean is in the process of evaluating courses currently active in our system. Due to the number of courses in our database, he will be contacting agencies individually for updates on their course status. If your agency has courses certified that are no longer active and will not be updated, please go to Course Change or Decertification form found on the Formatta page and submit the course for Decertification.
