Online PPRT Administrator and Proctor Courses



Just a reminder, the POST PPFT is a validated physical readiness test. It is not designed to measure fitness level, but rather the physical ability to complete those critical tasks that may occur within each category of peace officer. Obviously, the title can be confusing, but this is an important distinction.

To reduce confusion, we will be using the term PPRT (POST Physical Readiness Test) going forward.

Only those administering the test for <u>official record certification</u> purposes are required to be PPRT Administrator certified. Those who are conducting PPRT's for hiring/recruiting purposes, or in a capacity other than the officer's record certification PPRT, are not required to be PPRT Administrator certified.

PPRT Proctor Course

POST has prepared an informational online PPRT course specifically for attendees that only conduct non-record PPRT's. Those who attend this course will receive a Certificate of Completion but will not receive a PPRT Administrator's certification number. This course is located on nvelearn.nv.gov

PPRT Administrators Course

POST has updated the process to become a PPRT Administrator. The new process is a 2-part process containing online training and on-site training.

Those needing to be PPRT Administrator certified for the purposes of conducting PPRT's for record purposes will take the PPRT Administrator Course on nvelearn.nv.gov.

Once the course has been completed, the student will work with POST to attend and observe a PPRT. After the completion of the PPRT, the students will then complete the PPRT Administrators exam.

Upon the completion of the online training, on-site training, and the passing of the exam, the student will then be emailed their PPRT Administrators Certificate of Completion with their unique PPRT Administrator number.

To enroll in this course, students will need to work with their supervisor, manager or administrator of their agency and fill out the PPRT Administrator Course Nomination Sheet available on the forms page of our website at post.nv.gov/forms/ and submit the completed form to Mike Hayhurst at mhayhurst@post.state.nv.us.

National Decertification Index (NDI)

IADLEST created the National Decertification Index to serve as a national registry of certificate or license revocation actions related to officer misconduct. Records contained in NDI are provided by participating state government agencies and should be verified with the contributing authority. NV POST encourages Nevada law enforcement agencies to check NDI as part of their background process. Access to NDI can be obtained by going to the IADLEST website and clicking on the NDI section on the main page.

Nevada POST checks NDI upon receipt of any new hire paperwork and applications for basic certificates. Officers whose certifications/licenses that have been revoked in Nevada or another state cannot be certified in Nevada.

As a reminder to all agencies, there are requirements laid out in NAC 289 for notifying POST. Several examples of this are:

Per NAC289.290 (3) The employing agency shall notify the Commission any time that it becomes aware that one of its officers has been charged with a crime that could result in denial, suspension or revocation procedures. Upon receipt of information alleging any of the causes enumerated in subsection 1, the Commission will determine whether to pursue revocation or suspension of the certificate of the officer. This includes circumstances where an officer resigns or retires in lieu of termination during a criminal investigation.

Per NAC289.350(1) Upon employment or termination of a peace officer or upon the activation or termination of the reserve status of a reserve officer, an agency shall notify the Executive Director on a personnel action report form provided by the Commission or its designee. The personnel action report form must be submitted to the Executive Director within 15 days after the date of employment or termination of a peace officer or the activation or termination of the reserve status of a reserve officer.

If you have an officer in an academy, and they are not able to complete the certification PPRT within 16 weeks from the first day of their basic academy, the agency administrator can request an extension from the Executive Director. (The request needs to be submitted before the end of the 16 weeks). This also pertains to reciprocity. If your reciprocity hire cannot complete the certification PPRT before the end of the 16 weeks from date of hire, request an extension from the Executive Director. (NAC289.200(6))
