POSITION INFORMATION:

Under general supervision, performs a full range of police duties in the areas of patrol operations, criminal investigation, civil process, search and rescue, courtroom security and detention; and performs related work as assigned.

This is an Open Competitive / Countywide Promotional recruitment being conducted to fill current vacancies at the Washoe County Sheriff's Office. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be 21 years of age at the time of application

- Must possess a current and valid Nevada Commission on Peace Officer's Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.) Basic Category I Certificate at time of appointment or provide verification of current enrollment in a Nevada P.O.S.T. Basic Category I Academy at time of application.
- Out of state applicants must meet P.O.S.T. requirements per Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 289.200.
- Out of state applicants must pass the P.O.S.T. Academy challenge exam with a 70% or higher score within one (1) year.
- Candidates must meet P.O.S.T. requirements per Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 289 in its entirety.
- Must be a United States Citizen at time of application.
- Graduation from high school or possession of a General Education Development (G.E.D.) Certificate.

The Washoe County Sheriff Deputy Association (WCSDA) covers the Sheriff Deputy position. The provisions of the prospective collective bargaining unit therefore cover this position.

A person may not be appointed to perform the duties of a peace officer if he or she has:

- Been convicted of a felony in this State or of any offense which would be a felony if committed in this State Law.
- Been convicted of an offense involving moral turpitude or the unlawful use, sale or possession of a controlled substance; or a documented history of physical violence.

License or Certificate

- A valid Nevada Class C driver's license is required at the time of appointment and for continued employment in this classification
- Required to maintain Basic P.O.S.T. Certificate as Category I Peace Officer per NRS/NAC 289.
- Required to complete P.O.S.T. continuing education requirements in accordance with NRS/NAC 289.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

Upon successful completion of the PPFT* (POST Physical Fitness Test) and on-line exam, selected Candidates must:

- Complete and submit a Personal History Statement and pass an extensive background investigation.
- Submit a set of fingerprints.
- Successfully complete a Computerized Voice Stress Analysis (CVSA) examination. Submit to a psychological examination.
- Pass a thorough pre-employment medical examination in accordance with NAC 289.110, and drug screen.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT:

1. After your application is screened, you will be notified via the email you provided if you do not meet the minimum requirements for the position. Those applicants who do not meet the qualifications have five (5) working days to file an appeal, and request a review of their qualifications.

2. Applicants who meet the minimum requirements will receive an email invitation to take an online exam. Our Deputy Sheriff Tests are administered via remote, off-site testing by ProctorU for a fee of \$33.00 which goes to ProctorU. Approximately one month prior to testing, you will be notified by ProctorU that you can go online and schedule the date and time of your exam. If remote proctoring is not an option for you, please contact careers@washoecounty.gov.

The Deputy Sheriff exam covers:

- Understanding Written Information
- Written Communication
- Analytical Ability

Candidates who pass the on-line exam will be notified of the date of the PPFT which will be held in Reno, Nevada.

Post Physical Fitness Test – Certification:

- Vertical Jump - 14 inches
- Agility Run - 19.5 seconds
- Sit-ups – 30 (60 second time limit)
- Push-ups - 23 (no time limit)
- 300 meter sprint – 68 seconds
- 1.5 mile run – 16:57 (minutes: seconds)
